CHAPTER 6 "A" AGRICULTURE ZONE MIGRANT HOUSING – MOBILE HOMES FINDINGS OF FACT

Michigan Agriculture Labor Camp Act No. 368 of 1978. Department of Agriculture and Rural development environmental stewardship division agricultural labor camps.

- 1. "Camp" means an agricultural labor camp that is licensable under the authority of the act
- 2. The term "migratory" is used in this act seven times for reference to mobile homes. The term "temporary" us not used in this act.
- 3. Grants for migratory housing issued to the land owner range from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00
- 4. Shelters for migratory works can not be less than 100 sq. feet per occupant based on outside measurements of shelter.

- 5. Example of this requirement would be a mobile home as proposed 14ft X 70ft under act No. 368 could house 9.8 occupants.
- 6. If as proposed 4 mobile homes were placed on the site a total 39 occupants could be housed at one time on the site.
- 7. Review of current agriculture TLT property tax records.
 - A. 8 agriculture land owners own 100 plus acres.
 - B. 25 agriculture land owners own 40 99 acres.
 - C. 25 agriculture land owners own under 39 acres.
