5 Signs of a Scam

If you spot any of these tactics, stop, hang-up or walk away. You're probably being scammed.

1. **They contacted you** When you contact a business, you know who's on the other end of the line. But when someone contacts *you* first, you can't be certain they're telling the truth. You don't know if they are whom they say they are. And remember, email addresses and caller ID information can be faked.
2. **They dangle bait—usually money** Let's face it: People simply don't give away large sums of money easily. If someone dangles bait in front of you—a big prize, a shopping spree, an easy loan — for nothing, they're probably lying.
3. **They want your personal information** Anytime *anyone* asks for your personal information — bank accounts, social security number, etc. — you should be on alert. Don't give it away quickly or easily, especially to someone you don't know. You may become a victim of identity theft.
4. **You have to pay them first** If someone offers you a prize, debt relief, or employment — but first you have to pay an up-front fee to get it —you're probably being scammed.

Sheriff’s Office: Now at 209 Portage Dr., Bellaire

Sheriff Kevin Hoch’s office, the undersheriff’s office, sheriff’s administration staff, detectives, and deputies have been relocated to 209 Portage Dr. in Bellaire. “It’s great to have so many of the employees under one roof,” Sheriff Hoch said, adding his appreciation to the Board of Commissioners for their decision to make the change, and to all the departments who assisted with the move.

The Health Department will remain in the eastern part of the building. If voters approve a Public Safety Center, the Sheriff’s Office will relocate and the 209 Portage building will be repurposed.



County Building Exterior Renovations: February 2024 Update

The final phases of the project are in sight. Second floor carpet has been installed, new ceiling tiles are in place, the large “storefront” windows are in, and hallway/stairwell painting is complete. Windows are scheduled for an early March shipping. Funding for this safety-oriented renovation is primarily through the ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) grant.
