

**CHAPTER 6 "A" AGRICULTURE ZONE  
MIGRANT HOUSING – MOBILE HOMES**

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

**Michigan Agriculture Labor Camp Act No. 368 of 1978. Department of Agriculture and Rural development environmental stewardship division agricultural labor camps.**

- 1. "Camp" means an agricultural labor camp that is licensable under the authority of the act**
  - 2. The term "migratory" is used in this act seven times for reference to mobile homes. The term "temporary" is not used in this act.**
  - 3. Grants for migratory housing issued to the land owner range from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00**
  - 4. Shelters for migratory workers can not be less than 100 sq. feet per occupant based on outside measurements of shelter.**

- 5. Example of this requirement would be a mobile home as proposed 14ft X 70ft under act No. 368 could house 9.8 occupants.**
- 6. If as proposed 4 mobile homes were placed on the site a total 39 occupants could be housed at one time on the site.**
- 7. Review of current agriculture TLT property tax records.**
  - A. 8 agriculture land owners own 100 plus acres.**
  - B. 25 agriculture land owners own 40 – 99 acres.**
  - C. 25 agriculture land owners own under 39 acres.**
